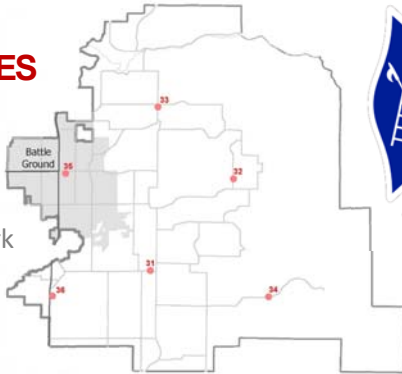

Fire District 3 operates under a balanced budget and has a Strategic Plan in place that guides our policy and spending decisions. We actively look for ways to be more cost-effective and maintain adequate reserves so our fire district is financially sound. Our daily operations are funded by a fire levy that is capped at \$1.50 per \$1,000 of assessed property value. Capital items, like fire stations, are funded by bonds. Within the next five years, the fire district anticipates asking voters for a lid lift to fund operations and a bond for a new station. Both funding sources require voter approval and are paid through property taxes.
