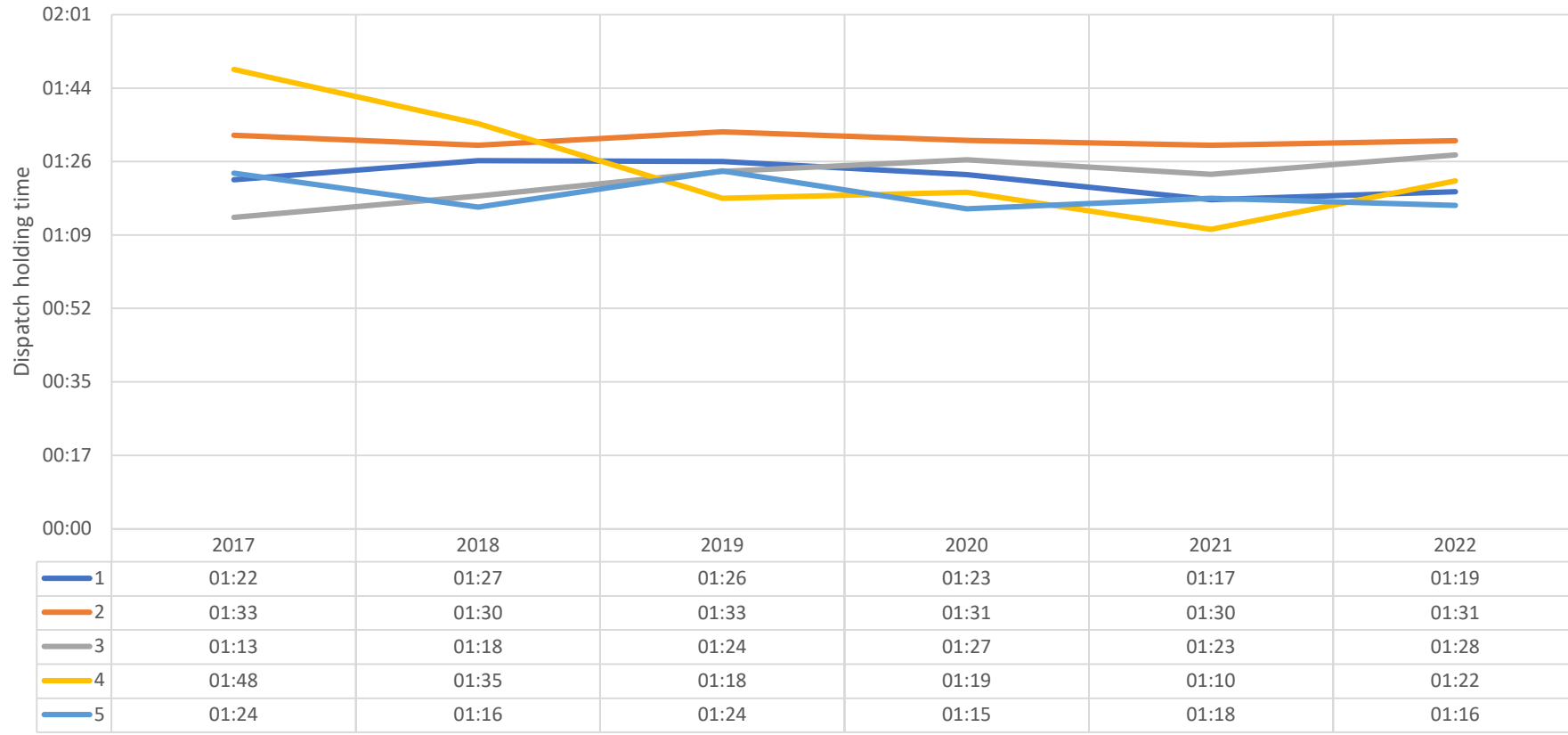
### CALL VOLUME BY YEAR BY BEAT 1/1/2016 - 12/31/2022 ALL PRIORITIES



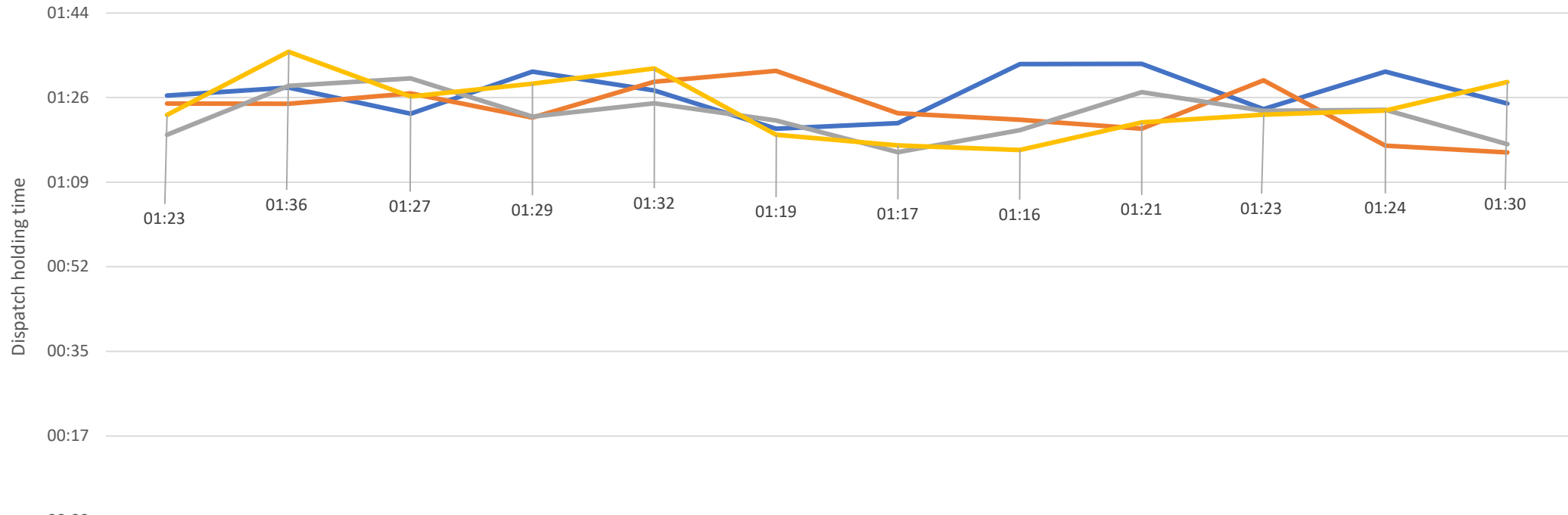
# Calculated Minutes to Incident 1/1/2016 - 12/31/22 All Priorities

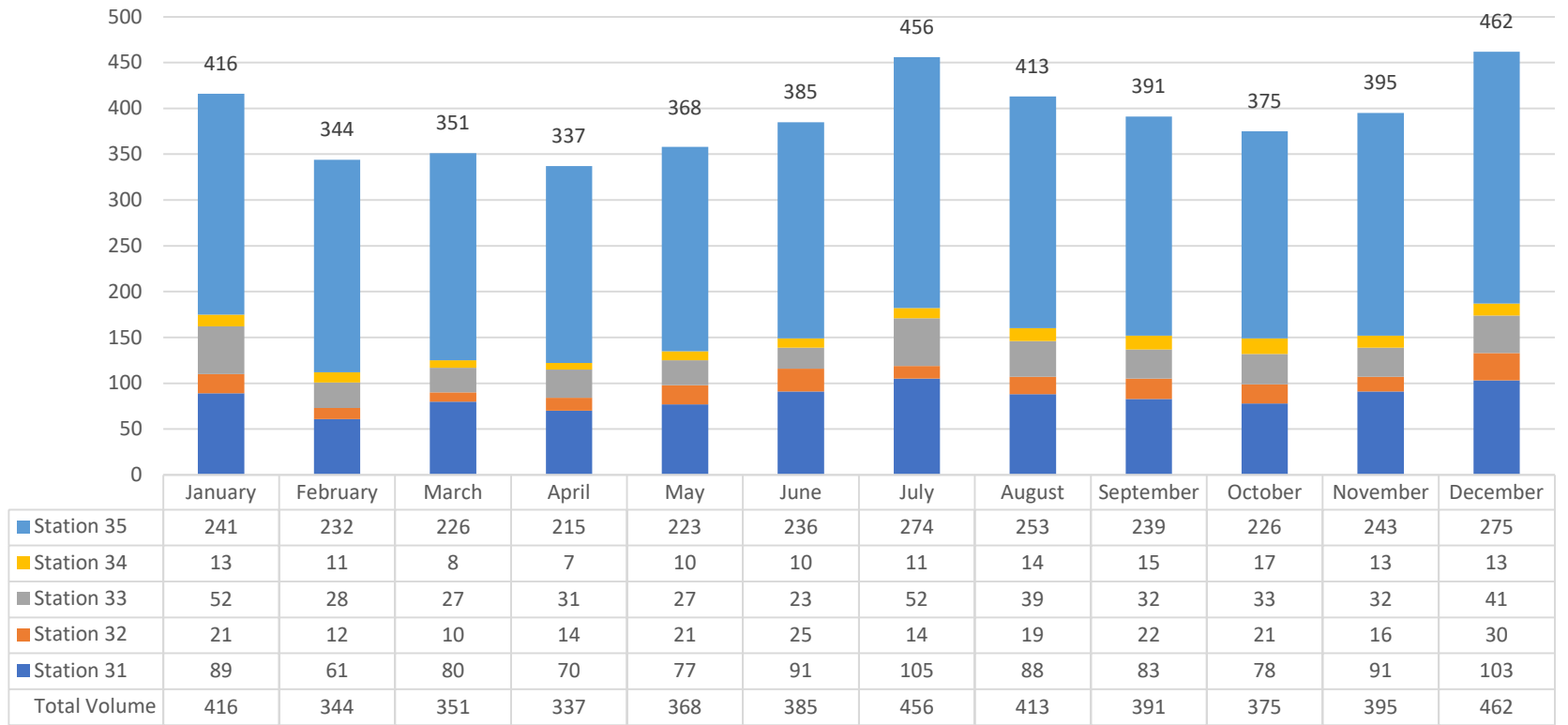

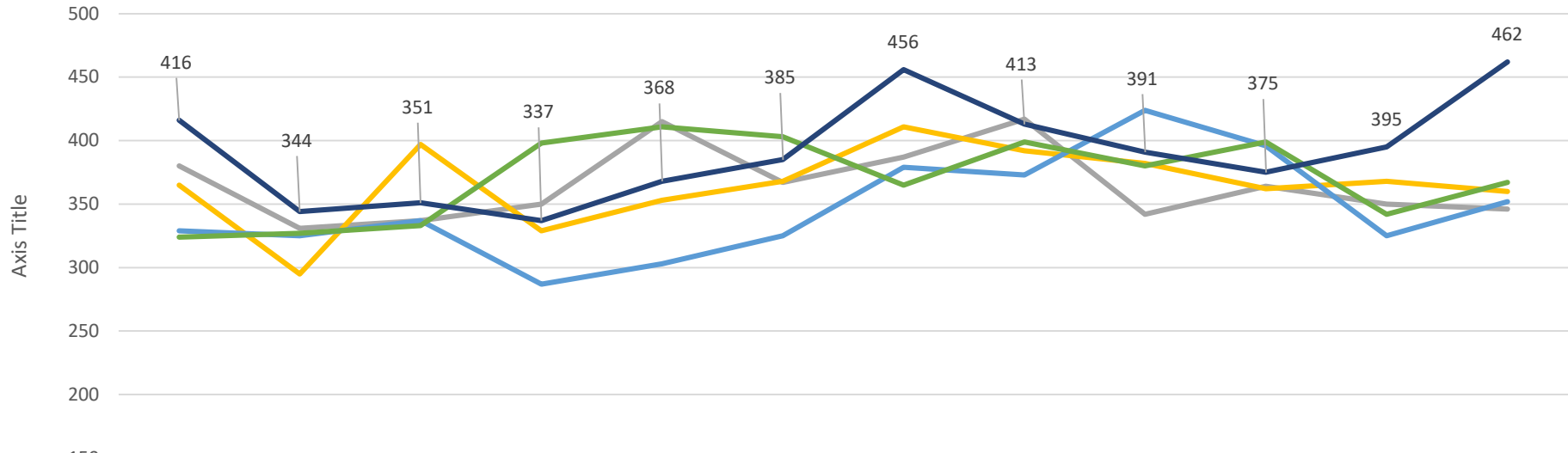

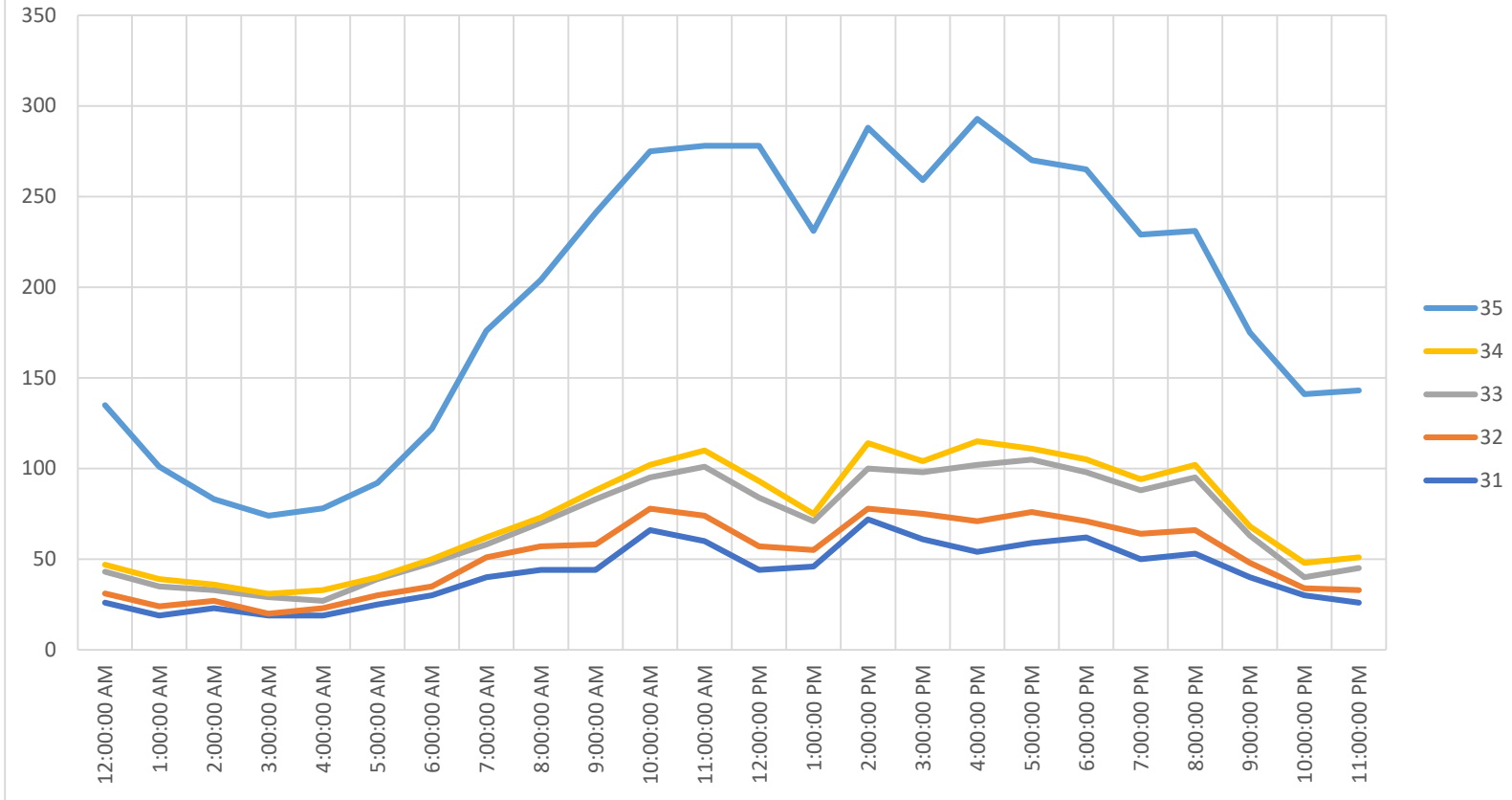


### In-District Call Volume by Year by Month



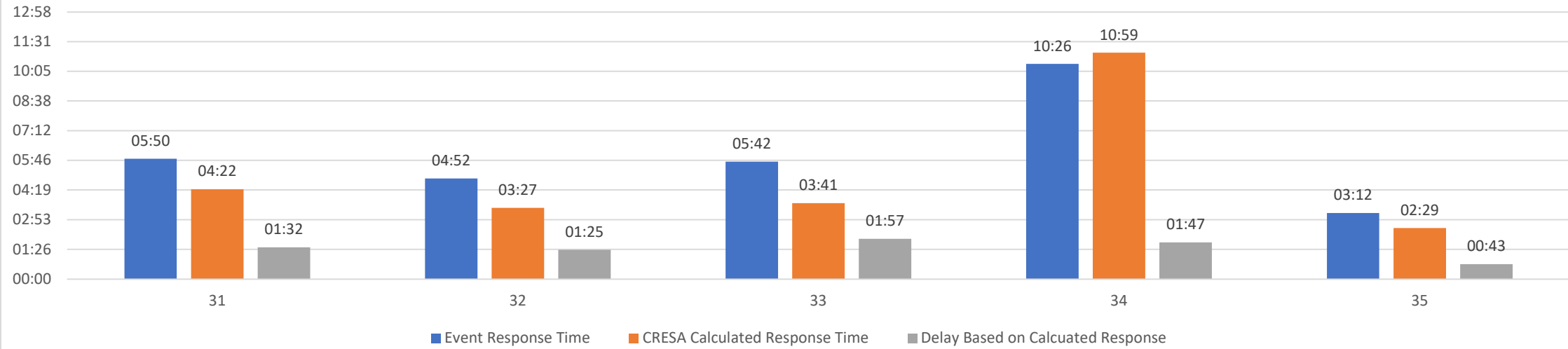

Calls by Time of Day by Station Area

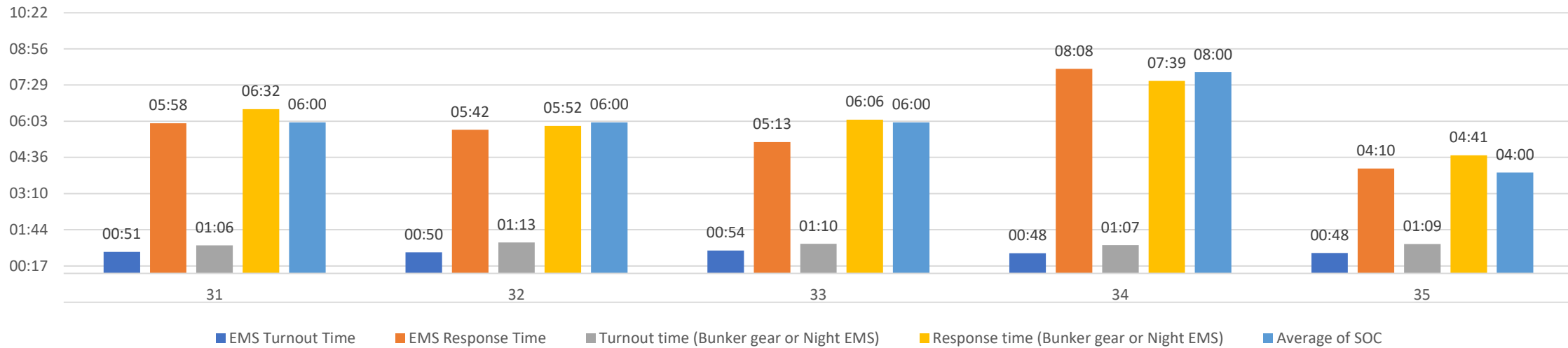




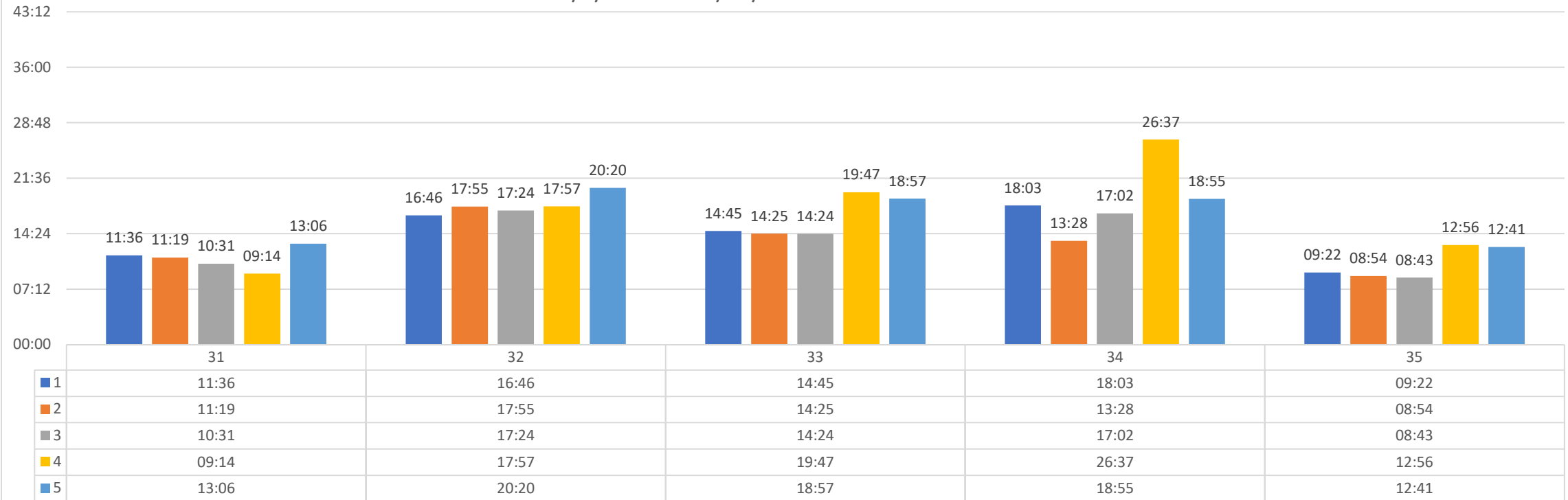
### Response Times Based on CRESA Dispatch All Priorities 1/1/2022 to 12/31/2022



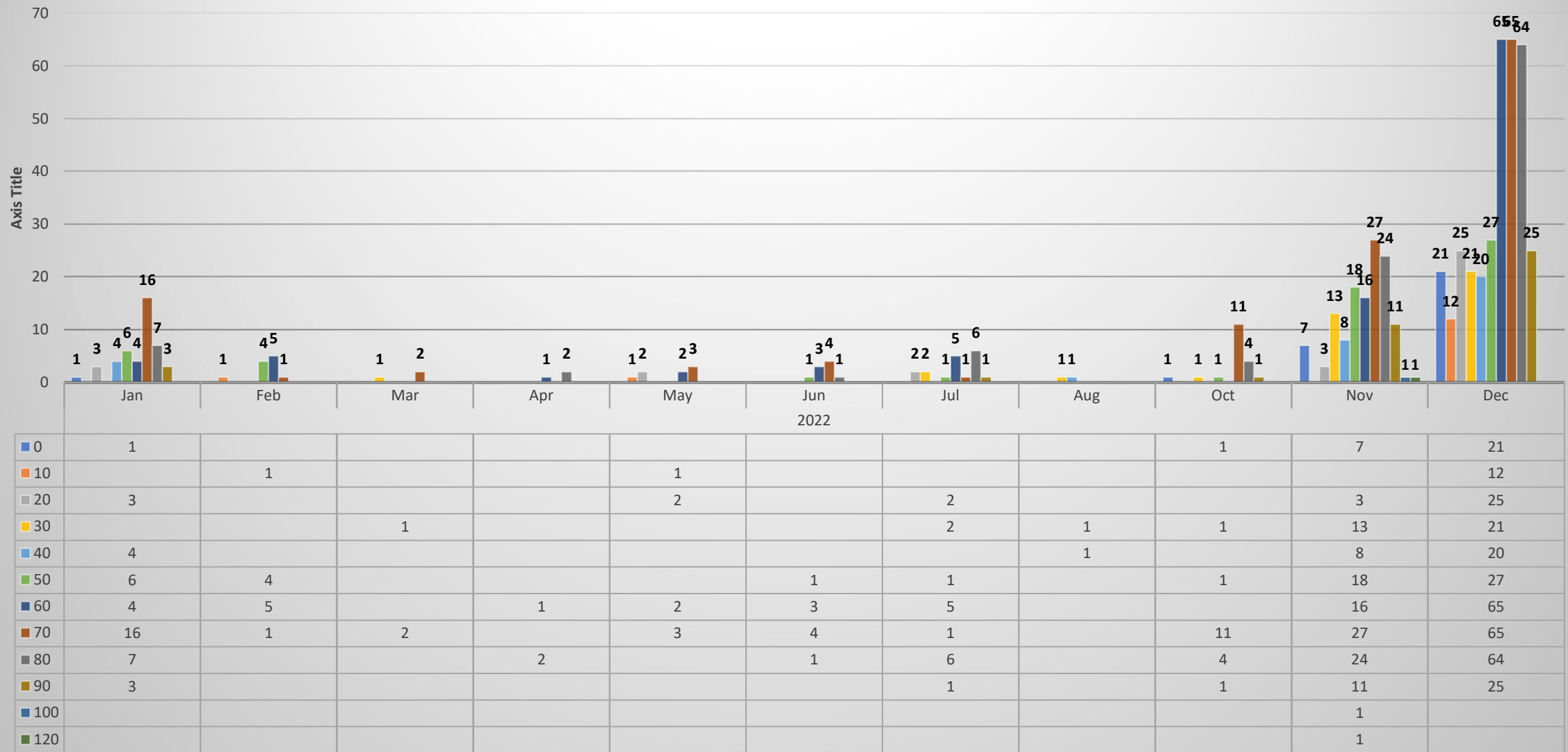
### Response Time by Station Area (90th Percentile and Priority 1-4) 1/1/2022 to 12/31/2022

 1/1/2022 to 12/31/2022

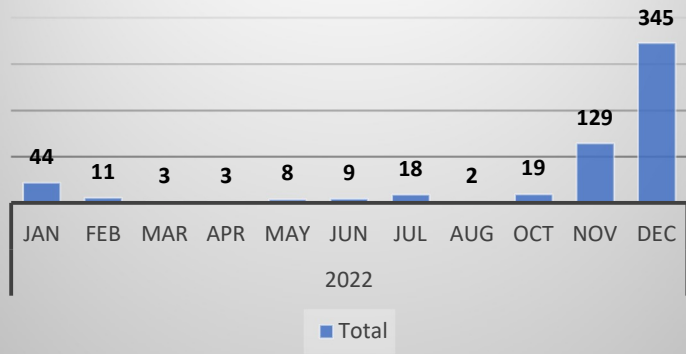


## Confirmed or Suspected COVID Patients by Patient Age

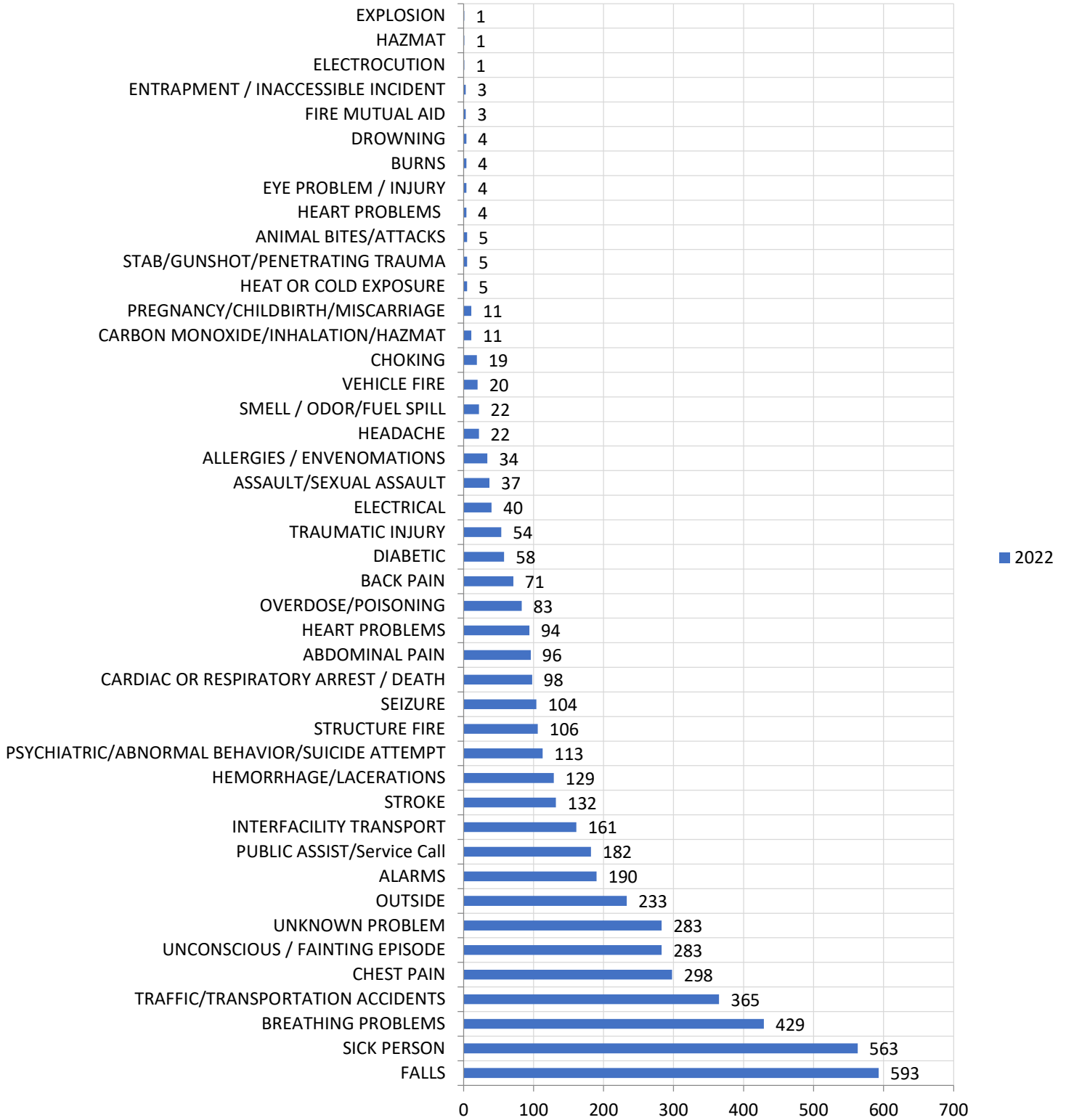
