<b>Penalty:</b> In addition to civil penalties, failure to comply with any provision of this and/or 90 days in jail.	permit is a misdemeanor subject to <b>fines of up to \$250</b>
<b>Expiration:</b> This permit expires one year from the date of issue. <b>Outdoor burning</b> each year. All burning permits will be rescinded between these two dates. Call resuming outdoor burning after September 30.
